Additional Information

ATTENDANCE DUES (subject to annual review) are a compulsory fee approved by the Ministry of Education and are payable to the Proprietor of the school, The Christian Schools' Trust (CST), for the provision of buildings and facilities together with other property related costs as required by the Ministry of Education under the Deed of Integration.

SPECIAL CHARACTER VOLUNTARY DONATION is the primary source of funds used to "maintain the school's Christian character". These are fixed by the Middleton Grange School Board and used to fund "elements of the school" that are not provided for in the Operations Grant provided by the Ministry of Education. These "elements" include the work and resource required to redevelop the NZ Curriculum into a biblically based Christ centred curriculum, professional development for staff around teaching Christianly, extra staffing to provide smaller classes and learning support, and service and missions based programmes. The Special Character Voluntary Donation has Tax deductible status, currently a 33% rebate.

EOTC (Education Outside the Classroom)

NB Category 1 and 2 Consent in no way removes the schools responsibility to keep you informed of events which will have your child off the school grounds. We understand our responsibility to keep you informed and to ensure that appropriate planning and supervision is in place to minimise any risks.

NOTE

- 1. If an interview is required, the school office will contact you to arrange a suitable time. Your son/daughter should accompany you.
- 2. Pursuant to the Privacy Act 2020 the following is brought to your attention:
 - a. This application form collects personal information about you and your child
 - b. Following confirmation of acceptance of placement offer, enrolment records held by previous schools will be requested
 - c. The information is collected in relation to the education services Middleton Grange School provides
 - d. Personal information may be passed to government agencies in statistical form as required by the Education & Training Act 2020 and other statutory requirements https://www.middleton.school.nz/privacy/
 - e. Non-identifying statistical information may be shared with other relevant agencies to help school planning and administration

MINISTRY OF EDUCATION YOUTH SERVICES Address and phone number details are collected at the time of enrolment and during the student's time at school so that the school can contact the parent or student as necessary. These contact details may also be passed on to the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Social Development (MSD). This is so young people who may have difficulty finding future employment, training or further education can be identified and offered support by organisations contracted by MSD to help re-engage young people in education or training when they leave school.
